## **NORWOOD MUSIC CAMP – TEN COMMANDMENTS**

### Understandings that will make Music Camp run effectively

- 1) BE ON TIME FOR ALL EVENTS, especially rehearsals. A 15-minute preparation period before all rehearsals should be a rule.
- 2) EVERYONE IS TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL SCHEDULED EVENTS  
No one will be permitted to be in his or her cabin or wandering around during a scheduled event except for an emergency. Do not leave valuables in cabins during rehearsals or activities.
- 3) EXPECTATIONS DURING MEALTIMES  
One person from each table will serve at all meals. The counselor at your table will ask you to take a day as a waiter for your table. Be at your best behavior. Remain seated during meals. Loud talking is discouraged. Hats are not to be worn indoors.
- 4) Food or beverage is not allowed in the cabins.
- 5) This is a beautiful camp; do your best to keep it that way. Do not litter or deface property. For your protection, do not run through wooded areas of camp. Shoes, preferably sneakers, must be worn at all times.
- 6) All instruments are to be left in the rehearsal hall. Care of instruments and music is essential.
- 7) NO SMOKING ANY TIME. Anyone with cigarettes or matches, e-cigarettes or vapes (or any similar devices) will immediately be sent home. Please refer to our Code of Conduct.
- 8) LIGHTS OUT WILL BE ANNOUNCED EACH EVENING. Anyone out of his or her cabin after the announced time will immediately be sent home.
- 9) There will be counselors and chaperones among you; You are responsible for your behavior; they are responsible for your safety. Give them your utmost cooperation.
- 10) You are representing your high school and your hometown. We think that you are a very special kind of person and know that you will live up to our expectations.
